He was present at the response to the Bethnal Green Tube Disaster in 1943 which saw the loss of 173 lives. The donor writes: 'according to my Father, the day of the 1975 ITV broadcast, he said my Grandfather stated that when the bodies were removed, there were no intertwined limbs or open eyes, all the bodies were stacked upon each other, with their eyes closed and looked as though they had passed away in their sleep'.</p> <p>Occupations: December 1915: attested - Private - Royal Army Medical Corps (RAMC) April 1917: called up to serve in the First World War March 1918: at Villers Brettoneux, France March 1919: with the Army of Occupation in Bonn, Germany (described it as 'a beautiful City'). 1927: Brush Maker - the business made toothbrushes 1939-1945: ARP Warden After 1945 - Packer (upon retirement)</p> <p>Residences: 1927-1940/1941(?): Mansford Street, Bethnal Green (1940-1941)-1970: Sturdee House, Peabody Estate, Bethnal Green</p> <p>Request: NO - This does not represent a physical document.
